THE WHITE EAGLE CATHAR

THIS IS THE second Christmas to pass since I began

this series of articles, and maybe it will be time soon to move on. Before I do, here are some more thoughts about Christmas from a Cathar perspective. I pointed out last Christmas how Cathars were aware –in a similar way to White Eagle –the dual nature of Jesus: the little human babe, born in a stable, to earthly parents, and one so much greater, whom White Eagle calls the Christ to distinguish him, the being who enables us to see the possibility of true spirit life and how it can be embodied. I have argued here that what is special about Cathars' belief is how they established a real sense of living the true spirit life on earth, by virtue of the extraordinary responsibility held by the parfait, that of actually living the life of Christ. And in imitation of the Cathars, the birth that we seek through our work in the Lodge is to bring about, collectively, that elusive 'standard of life which is in harmony with the infinite love', a phrase so often quoted in our documents.

So I find myself wondering, through the message of Christmas and the message of the Cathars, how can we best bring about that extraordinary achievement? First, I suppose, we should turn to the message Christmas brings above all: the innocence of the little child. It is a gift of the imagination, partly: the eyes of a tiny child whom we see in pram or on shoulder speak so easily to us of our home above, which the baby has so recently left. The simple gifts we exchange are messages of love, just as they were when the Magi brought them to Jesus. They are messages of respect, too, respect for the Christ within every one whom we bless with our gift or even just honour with a card. 'The light in me salutes the light in you' is the perfect message of those gifts, and if they are humble gifts, so much the more so. We remember at Christmas that truth is essentially simple, and that in White Eagle's message as in all religions, it comes down to just two things: to act with kindness and to be grateful, which is the same as to be mindful.

Simplicity is so deeply the message of Christmas, that many of us, I think, shudder at the complexity materiality places upon it. White Eagle actually helps us to enjoy the fun: I find myself sometimes much less able than he seems to be to rise above the depression London's Oxford Street sets off in me as the Christmas shopping season approaches its peak. Materialism is depressing: in the scheme of things it is actually meant to be, I believe, until we redeem it by seeing the light in all of it and thus 'redeem' it. And that is Cathar too.

But to work from simple mindfulness, gratitude for the moment, is the best way to overcome the towers of material wealth that have so little of care lodged in them.

Care, yes, The Cathar *parfait* was mindful of the duty of care, always. His or her most important task was to be with the dying, to make sure that their material death was a birth into spiritual light. That normally meant administering the *consolamentum*, if the dying one was ready. If it is beautiful to

one dying, and many readers will have heard me speak of how the light in the whole of my mother's countenance as she lay dying convinced me that she was most consciously 'walking into the light' as she passed. Maybe for those facing their first Christmas after a bereavement to think of death as birth will itself be comforting: it certainly is for me, three years after Ylana died.

I have written of how the *parfaits* travelled not just from chateau to chateau but from simple home to simple home. Every home they went to was, in its own way, a stable or a cave. Legend has it that the Cathars used caves as places of initiation. I am not quite sure how well founded the legend is, but I am certainly convinced that the symbolism of a cave is right for initiation. We go right into the darkness, facing the loss of the physical sun, reminding ourselves of its endless continuation and coming through into a greater light.

I think I am right in saying that the tradition of a Christmas crib, a reenactment in clay, wood or (today) plastic figures of all those who traditionally stood around the newborn Jesus in his cave or stable, goes back to St Francis. Francis was almost exactly contemporary with the Cathars, and there is an intriguing possibility that his father was exposed to Cathar thought in northern Italy, while his mother came from roughly the Cathar area in southern France. It's far too much of an assumption to think of the Christmas crib as Cathar, but contemplation of this simple creation at the least takes us back to the uncomplex devotionalism of the mediaeval mind.

How lovely it would be if we could also show that in the Cathar one of the symbols that most resonated was the Star of Bethlehem! Sadly our scant records of them do not include this symbol as far as I know, and yet I am sure we rightly connect with them (we in the Lodge) as a manifestation of the same brotherhood as ourselves. 5

Dear Cathars, we are with you at this time, we who hold the responsibility now that you held once! Our enemies, the agents of materialism, are not so different from the ones you faced. You saw them in a powerful church, and in greedy nobles who swept down on you from the northern lands. Our greedy nobles are there, too; our powerful church is the church of consumerism; and our message is just as yours. Be simple; be kind; be non-violent to all, including animals; love all, however different their perspective from our own; let the material world have no hold on us. And in this new age, let us be non-violent to ourselves too: see the little child within our own hearts, and bring our gifts to that too. Happy Christmas!

THE DIVINE FEMININE

In the Lodge we routinely speak of and to Father and Mother God, which feels intuitively right. It is comforting to feel our Creator, the Great Spirit, is like our parents: knows us personal-

ly, is strong, loving and forgiving. My thoughts currently have centered on a question to myself about my relationship with Mother God. I haven't had a clear enough sense of her as herself, separate from Father God, and have been wondering why, and hoping to do better.

Talking about our understanding of, and relationship with, the Great Spirit, White Eagle says, "Fundamentally, there is only one religion. How can we describe it? It is a state of *affinity* with *infinity*. Religion is a permeating essence in life, and the spirit of a person needs to become in harmony or affinitized to this permeating, infinite essence. Do we mean then that God is an abstract essence, and has no human relationship with ourselves or other people? No. God is our Father...our Mother also." So he brings the idea of God right into our hearts, to the human relationships fundamental to our being. It is Divine Mother who creates form. Mothering is essential not only for our birth but for the loving, nurturing, healing, intuitive qualities we think of as feminine.

The ideas of Mother Earth and of Divine Mother seem closely related and have perhaps been so for long ages. Our relationship with our beloved Mother Earth was in earlier times, and still is in indigenous cultures, one of inclusivity, of recognition of the way all of Nature, including humans, is intertwined. All of life, every thing, is sacred, and as the feminine in humans comes to greater focus, we are beginning to understand this and relate more gently with all the lives around us.

White Eagle tells us that human beings all have both male and female qualities, and that whether born as men or women we need to nurture in ourselves the qualities of the other gender. Then he says, "What do we see in the world today? Why is there such terrible suffering? Because humanity has starved itself of the Mother principle for many centuries. There has been domination, first by the body and then by the intellect or brain. Both have tended to imprison, if not slay, the divine Mother-principle, which is wisdom and love. In the future will come this illumination, this initiation, this expansion of spiritual consciousness. You will see this mother aspect – not merely woman, for we are speaking of divine principles- you will see this divine principle of the Mother slowly but surely influencing the world. As a result there will be



a much greater inflow of love and wisdom; a lessening of the powercomplex which , working through the human brain, causes individuals to produce the most diabolical machinery for the destruction of life. When the spirit of the Mother works hand in hand with the true Father principle (which is the higher, the divine mind), you will get a return to sanity, to harmony, to happiness."

He goes on to say, "As the years go by you will see women less and less excluded from high office, but given their correct, honourable place in the affairs of the world. The soul, or the woman aspect of your make-up, is that aspect which inspires praise and worship. It is the soul that is stirred in religious service. Music can arouse the soul. The ritual of religion can stimulate and stir the soul. And all the time the soul is developing this feeling, this intuition, which is enabling the spirit to contact matter, to come into greater manifestation in matter." This seems hugely important: as our souls, the woman aspect of ourselves, is fed or stimulated and so we, in our small individual lives, contribute to the evolution of consciousness that the current turmoil is the background for.

The growth of the feminine in the world, is not totally a matter of simply having more women in government, of course, although that is a most helpful and necessary part of the change towards balance and harmony. Feminine qualities need generally to be more highly valued and nurtured in a male -dominated world. For myself, I realise that I fear being seen as pushy, when putting forward my opinion, having grown up in a world where women were definitely seen as secondary to men. I need to practise speaking up fearlessly!

And of course many women are doing just that, raising all of our awareness of the ways in which many men have undervalued us as humans, at the same time as many men are coming to recognise the existence of their feminine aspect and to allow that to enlarge their understanding and their experience. They can enjoy taking care of their babies, for instance, and allow themselves to cry, even. White Eagle is, as always, very positive about the direction we are moving in: "We see everywhere signs of the coming of the light to humanity. We see this in the stimulation of the Mother-aspect, or the feminine aspect of life. Women have the vision, and are beginning to take their proper place in order to bring about a more perfect balance in the world. For there comes a time when the soul has to learn and understand the law of equilibrium. Until man and woman live in perfect partnership, each playing their part in the evolution of the race, there cannot be real progress. With the coming of this feminine aspect and the balancing of life there will be great progress on your earth. There must be equality; spiritual equality, mental equality, there must be mutual respect and true partnership between man and woman. This new state of affairs will mitigate many of the ills which still exist."

White Eagle has more to say about Divine Mother's work in the world. He reminds us that the wise human mother must at times withhold nurturing her child in order to teach him or her a necessary lesson. She loves unconditionally and wants the best for her child, so she sets limits, takes something away, perhaps. And so he says, "The Mother aspect of God is dual, and destroys as well as creates. Before the new age of Aquarius can fully be ushered in, there has to be a breaking-down of old conditions. When a condition has served its purpose it must be absorbed, it must go, and this is the value of the destructive element in life. We would give you a true perspective of the value of destruction - of the clearing away of old methods and old ideas, and of making ready for the coming of the good, the true and the beautiful." Trying to grasp the idea of Divine Mother as a destroyer brings the thought that death is just as wonderful, mysterious and profound an experience as birth. Maledominated culture, while suppressing the feminine has also fostered fear of dying. Death can be thought of as birth into the next chapter of our spirit's life. As Divine Mother and her angels are present for every birth, she and they are present for every passage into the world of Light.

Pondering these ideas, I can find comfort in the understanding that Divine Mother is, in her loving wisdom, at work. She is clearing away outworn institutions and ideas, producing what we see on the material plane as utter chaos and dreadful suffering. And this is so that a new age, balanced and harmonious between men and women, and the planet Earth, can grow, as we in the Lodge continue in the work she has given us, radiating her light which is vital to the emergence of the world we are all waiting to see.



Only through love and thought-power can humanity be touched, helped and guided. Only thoughts of a constructive nature can assist the great masses of the unhappy and the suffering. Plant thought as a seed and action will follow. White Eagle



THE NEW TEMPLE AT NEW LANDS By Jeremy Hayward

My colleague Tom has recently shared a short video of the four beautiful curved arches that form the circle of the new temple here at new lands, which I hope Facebook friends have enjoyed. In this short post I want to go several weeks back in time to a little ceremony six of us held on the temple site when there were just the foundations visible.



When the original temple was being built, White Eagle specifically asked that a star on a cross-within-the-circle, made out of copper, should be laid into the concrete screed of the floor right in the centre of the circle of the temple - but which would be hidden by the carpet. he said that the purpose of this was a kind of spiritual alchemy and had to do with the vortex of spiritual energy which came into the building through the stained glass cross-within-the circle window at the centre of the dome, which needed to be earthed in the floor beneath. The copper, he said, would help to do this.

As most readers will know, we have ensured that the centre point of the new temple is exactly in the same position as the centre of the old, symbolic of retaining all the spiritual power built up in the original building, in the new. And we have again laid a copper star on a copper cross-within-the-circle in the screed in the floor of the new building right underneath what will be an engraved glass rose star window in the oculus at the centre of the new dome.

We felt it was right to hold a little ceremony for the placing of this new symbol in the bare foundations of the new building.

And so one damp Monday afternoon at the summer solstice (June 21st) six of us gathered on the building site under the distant watchful eye of the construction firm's site manager. We positioned the copper symbol exactly where it would be laid in the floor screed. And then four of us stood back a few yards from the centre, at the compass points of North (Earth), South (Air), East (Water) and West (Fire). We each in turn gave a short reading from White Eagle's teaching evoking and invoking the blessing and power of that element, blessing the copper star in the centre of our circle. We then finished with a closing prayer.

I was East / Water and I did not know what to expect as I began my reading, feeling quite exposed out there on the damp hilltop among the foundations. I need not have worried. Underneath the words I was speaking I felt from beyond me a surge of energy lifting me up, that is difficult to describe. It felt at once an affirmation of the deep importance of the new building and the future work that would take place there, and a blessing on the heart centre of the

building. It felt like a confirmation from the brethren in spirit of their presence and their guidance, personally to me and in reassurance to us all. And it felt like a wellspring of love at the heart of the new temple.We eventually went our separate ways, I to New Lands chapel to do our Star brotherhood work that we normally do on Monday evenings. But underneath all I did I felt this loving wellspring of spiritual power, lifting me out of my habitual self. It said (to quote White Eagle's words) 'How can you doubt, how can you fear, when you know the power in which you are being held?' And quietly in my heart and then out loud I gave thanks.

Apple Loaf

- 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- 1 ½ tsp. cinnamon
- 2/3 cup white sugar
- $\frac{1}{2}$ cup unsalted butter, room temp.
- 2 eggs
- 2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 ½ cups flour
- 1 ½ tsp. baking powder
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1-2 apples peeled and chopped
- Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 9x5 loaf pan.
- Mix brown sugar and cinnamon in a bowl, put to the side.
- In another bowl combine white sugar and butter, cream until smooth.
- Add eggs and vanilla, stir until everything is combined.
- Add flour and baking powder, then milk.
- Pour half of the batter into the loaf pan, cover with half of the apples.
- Sprinkle with half of the cinnamon mixture.
- Pour the remaining batter in the loaf pan, then the remaining chopped apples and all that is left of the cinnamon mixture.
- Bake for 50 minutes.
- Cool for 10 minutes, remove from loaf pan .
